

Town Manager Report - April 2023

This month has been busy for the entire town staff.

More trees have been trimmed on Morton Street. A pothole at the corner of Clark Avenue and Hoffman Street was repaired with new black top.

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has been and will be on State Road 16 trimming all the trees and maintaining the tree canopy from one end of town to the other. They will be working intermittently, so they may do part now and then come back and finish the entire length of the town. This is done every ten years.

The Town has received its quarterly inspection on State Road 16 and has passed with flying colors! We are now getting into the heavy mowing, weed-eating and edging season for the public works staff.

The Town's Water Administrator, Josh Young has studied for and taken his Class D water license test and passed. Congratulations to Josh!

The new playground equipment has been delivered and placed. The public works staff is busy repainting the hobby horses, placing new signs up and preparing the remaining grounds. The new mulch will be delivered in the first part of May.
