

Town Manager Report - August 2021

Construction is still ongoing for the storm water project and the entire process is being documented and put on our Diamond Maps program, by the public works department. This is still the major project happening in the Town now. I would like to remind residents to stay out of the construction areas. The areas are marked and we want to keep everyone safe. Residents who live near or in the areas affected, please stay on the sidewalks. The contractor has stated the entire project is now estimated to be finished by September 30, 2021.

The Penney Farms museum renovation is coming along and should be completed by the end of September. This project will be a nice addition to the Town and a focal point for future visitors.

New storm drain guards have been installed on Haymon Avenue to provide more safety for the children in the area.

The Town's Audit was presented this month and again for the 8th year in a row there has been no findings. I want to commend the front office staff for their excellent work.

One of the two pumps at the Etheleen Court lift station been pulled and a new pump has been ordered. In addition, one of the three pumps at the master lift station has been pulled and is being rebuilt.
