This month began with a couple of leaks being fixed on Saunders Road and at the corner of Lewis Avenue and Gwinn Street. These leaks took a whole week to find and get repaired. These repairs were documented and more information was put into the Diamond Map program.

Cathie Parrott and I provided a presentation to the Clay County Finance Committee to try and obtain money for the Town of Penney Farms Historic Museum.

The front office received a new copier. With this new copier, the contract provides for unlimited color and black & white copies. This will provide a significant savings to the Town. There will be no more quarterly charges for overages.

The Town's Annual Audit was completed by Powell & Jones. I can report, that the Town has no findings for the fifth year in a row. The shows that the Town staff has done a great job again, this year.

Tim Plymel with Florida Rural Water Association (FRWA) came to the Town with camera equipment to help find a sewer lateral location.

Vector Security came out and repaired the camera settings at the Water Tower Building.
