The month of March began with the Town office staff finally being able to move into the newly renovated front offices. There is still quite a bit of re-organizing going on, but the staff is happy to be in their own spaces.

There was another major leak on Saunders Road that had to be repaired. The Town is now in the process of replacing the entire water line in that area. This will be an ongoing repair for the next few weeks.

Another water line break was repaired on Clark Avenue.

There has been more mapping of the underground pipe infrastructure, on the Penney Retirement Community (PRC) campus, ahead of the start of the storm water repair project to begin next month.

The front parking area of the Town Hall was blacktopped. There were several requests to get this done and it looks much better.

The Penney Retirement Community Circle of Family and Friends event was held and I thank the administration for the invite and enjoyed the dinner. The Pickle Ball court has been completed and looks wonderful. I attended the dedication and enjoyed seeing the excitement of the new facilities from the residents.
