

# Town Manager Report - October 2021

The Storm water project is nearing completion. New street paving and curbs have been installed on Poling Blvd. and paving was done on Clark Avenue. New sod was laid on Poling Blvd. and Clark Avenue and the final clean up should make the project conclude in November.

The Penney Farms museum renovation has been completed and the final building inspections have been approved. The Town of Penney Farms Historical Society is now locating and sorting through its inventory, which will be displayed inside the museum. The Grand Opening for the museum is tentatively set for November 30, 2021.

Florida Pump installed a new pump at the master lift station and it is working correctly now.

Individual meter calibrations are currently being performed on all of the water utility customers to ensure accuracy and locate the need for replacement meters.

The Planning & Zoning Commission is continuing its meetings to review the Town's Comprehensive Plan and Land Development Regulations. The Commission and the Town's planner are reviewing these documents to ensure they are up to date and to be prepared for future development in the Town of Penney Farms.
