

Town Manager Report - September 2021

Construction is still ongoing for the storm water project. All of the storm water pipe has been installed. The new street paving and final clean up should be completed in October. I know this has been a long and drawn out project, but it is almost done. I appreciate the residents' patience and understanding during this process.

The Penney Farms museum renovation is almost complete. The new carpet has been installed and the ADA restrooms have been tiled. The Kurt and Sharon Legait have purchased and donated four new display cases for the museum and they have been assembled. Mrs. Cathie's desk has been assembled and she will have her office in the museum part of the building, when the renovation is complete. In a few weeks the renovation will be complete. A grand opening is being planned. This project will be a nice addition to the Town and a focal point for future visitors. In addition, the public works staff built from scratch two new benches and a garbage can container which have been placed in front of the museum.

The Town is planning on fine tuning some landscaping in the front of the Town Hall and museum when the building renovations have been completed.

The new front office staff are still in training and the main focus this month was preparing for the public hearings for the new fiscal year budget and fulfilling all those requirements. In addition, the staff has been preparing all files for the new fiscal year and closing the current year. It is another extremely busy time of the year.

New sidewalk railings have been installed along Clark Avenue across from Kohler Park. The Town's public works staff built and installed the much needed railings.

The Town has received another \$50,000.00 grant to upgrade the playground park. The Town intends to upgrade some of the play equipment, screen in the pavilion building and get new fencing, which would be more appealing.

A new pump was put in the Etheleen Court lift station, to replace the one that stopped working.
